

## **Chris Brown, Assistant Men and Women's Tennis Coach & Sports Information Assistant**

**Chris Brown** joins the Elmira College Athletics Department in his first years as the Assistant Men and Women's Tennis Coach and Sports Information Assistant. **Brown**, a 2011 graduate of Neumann University was a four-year member of the men's tennis program, including being named Conference Player of the Year three times. Not only did he compete on the tennis courts, but he also was a two-year member of the men's cross country team.



During his senior season **Brown** was captain of the men's tennis team, compiling an impressive 7-3 record at first singles. **Brown's** success is also evident in the classroom, internships and campus organizations.
