

ELMIRA COLLEGE AND TOMPKINS CORTLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
NURSE EDUCATION COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENT

The following is an agreement of understanding between the Nurse Education Program at Tompkins Cortland Community College and the Nurse Education Program at Elmira College for A.A.S. degree students entering the B. S. Program in Nursing.

1. Students must successfully complete the Nursing A.A.S. Degree Program at Tompkins Cortland Community College.
2. Students successfully completing the A.A.S. degree in Nursing, upon application, will be guaranteed admission to the Elmira College Baccalaureate Program in Nursing through the Office of Admissions (full-time student status) or the Office of Continuing Education (part-time student status).
3. Students will be granted 20 nursing credits equivalent to NSG 2510, 2520, 3110, 3130, and 3900.
4. Students will be allowed to transfer in 80 credits from Tompkins Cortland Community College including the equivalent nursing credits.
5. Depending upon the courses transferred, more than 120 credits may be required for program completion.
6. The Associate Degree Program at Tompkins Cortland Community College will provide A.A.S. students information about this collaborative agreement and related requirements.
7. The Nurse Education Director at Tompkins Cortland Community College and the Nurse Education Director at Elmira College will establish and maintain liaison activities for distribution of information and the effective advising of students.
8. This collaborative plan will be reviewed for effectiveness in meeting the educational needs of nursing students and mechanisms of program offerings as needed.
9. This collaborative plan will be effective for only graduates of the A.A.S. in the Nursing major at Tompkins Cortland Community College.
